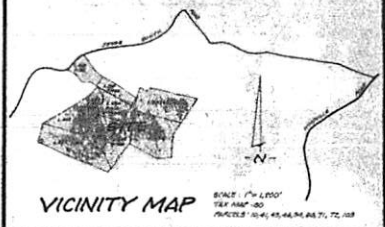


Surveyor's Certificate
